## Dorothy Height Elementary School Dress Code





With MCSD Board approval, a school uniform policy has been adopted. <u>ALL</u> students are required to wear uniforms <u>Monday</u> through <u>Friday</u> with the following exceptions:

- Jeans with no holes on Fridays only if worn with official school t-shirt
- Picture Days (when communicated out of or red uniform shirt uniform)
- Other Announced Special Events

**Shirts:** Collared <u>red</u> polo-style uniform shirt or dress shirt (long or short sleeves) with no emblems.

**Bottoms: Beige khaki** uniform pants, skirts, shorts, capris, skorts, and jumpers. Bottoms cannot be oversized and must be worn at natural waist. A belt must be worn if bottoms are not fitted at the waist. Shorts, skirts, etc. cannot be more than 3 inches above the knees.

All clothing worn in the building (including sweaters, fleeces, lightweight jackets, etc) must be red.



School spirit sweatshirts are approved to wear on regular uniform days and spirit days.

Coats worn outside/recess do not have to be in uniform colors.

Not Approved to wear: crocs, slides, high heels, flip flops
