On Monday, January 17, we will be observing Martin Luther King Jr. Day which celebrates his life and legacy as an American civil rights leader. Martin Luther King Jr. was born January 15, 1929 in Atlanta, GA. He was an emerging leader of the civil rights movement for eight years leading up to his famous "I Have a Dream" speech on August 28, 1963, delivered from the steps of the Lincoln Memorial in Washington, D.C. He went on to win the Nobel Peace Prize in 1964 "for his non-violent struggle for civil rights for the Afro-American population". Dr. King embodied the values of justice, courage, dignity, and service and is remembered as one of the most influential nonviolent leaders in world history. We can honor his memory by learning from his legacy, and volunteering in the community to make it better.

Academic English vs. Social English

Academic English and social English are not two separate languages. Academic English is more demanding and complex than social English. An ELL (English Language Lerner) student with social English proficiency may not necessarily have the academic English proficiency. It is important for you and the teacher to make this distinction. Academic English is the language necessary for success in school. It is related to a standards-based curriculum, including the content areas of math, science, social studies, and English language arts.

ELLs come to school not only to learn how to communicate socially, but to become academically proficient in English. Just because they can speak on the playground, talk to peers, and use every day English does not mean that they are up to speed in academic English. To the contrary, these ELLs are not yet proficient enough to handle the standards-based curriculum. They lack the academic vocabulary needed to develop the content knowledge in English that they will need to succeed in future schooling. By recognizing these two types of proficiencies, you can help expedite your ELLs' academic English.

Inglés académico vs. Inglés social

El inglés académico y el inglés social no son dos sistemas lingüísticos separados. El inglés académico es más exigente y complejo que el inglés social. Un estudiante ELL (Aprendiz del idioma inglés, siglas en inglés, English Language Lerner) con dominio del inglés social no necesariamente tendrá dominio del inglés académico. Es importante que usted y la maestra hagan esta distinción. El inglés académico es el lenguaje necesario para tener éxito en la escuela. Se relaciona con un programa basado en los estándares, en el que se incluyen las áreas de contenidos de matemáticas, ciencias, estudios sociales, y lengua y literatura inglesas.

Los estudiantes ELL no sólo vienen a la escuela para aprender a comunicarse socialmente, sino también para adquirir un dominio académico del idioma inglés. Simplemente porque pueden hablar en el patio de recreo, conversar con sus pares y utilizar el inglés cotidiano no significa que avancen al mismo ritmo con el inglés académico. Al contrario, estos estudiantes ELL aún no tienen el dominio suficiente para llevar adelante el programa de estudios basado en los estándares. Carecen del vocabulario académico necesario para desarrollar los conocimientos de contenidos en inglés que necesitarán para triunfar en su experiencia escolar futura. Al reconocer estas dos clases de dominio del idioma, usted podrá ayudar a sus estudiantes ELL a acelerar su aprendizaje del inglés académico.


