

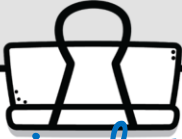

WHO are School Social Workers?

School Social Workers are professionals who provide services related to a person's social, emotional and life adjustment to school and/or society. School Social Workers are the link between the home, school and community in providing direct as well as indirect services to students, families and school personnel to promote and support students' academic and social success.

WHAT are some of the specific services that School Social Workers provide?

- Monitor and address attendance as outline by the GA Compulsory Attendance Law
- Working with those problems in a child's living situation that affect the child's adjustment in school. (home, school, and community)
- Mobilizing family, school, and community resources to enable the child to learn as effectively as possible in his or her educational program
- Working with parents to facilitate their support in their children's school adjustment.
- Alleviating family stress to enable the child to function more effectively in school & community.
- Assisting parents in accessing & utilizing school and community resources.
- Providing staff with essential information to better understand factors (cultural, societal, economic, familial, health, etc.) affecting a student's performance and behavior.
- Obtaining and coordinating community resources to meet students' needs.

TIPS FOR GREAT ATTENDANCE

- Establish regular bedtime and morning time schedules
- Avoid vacations and extended trips while school is in session
- Schedule medical appointments after school if possible
- Send children to school unless truly sick
- Arrive to school on time

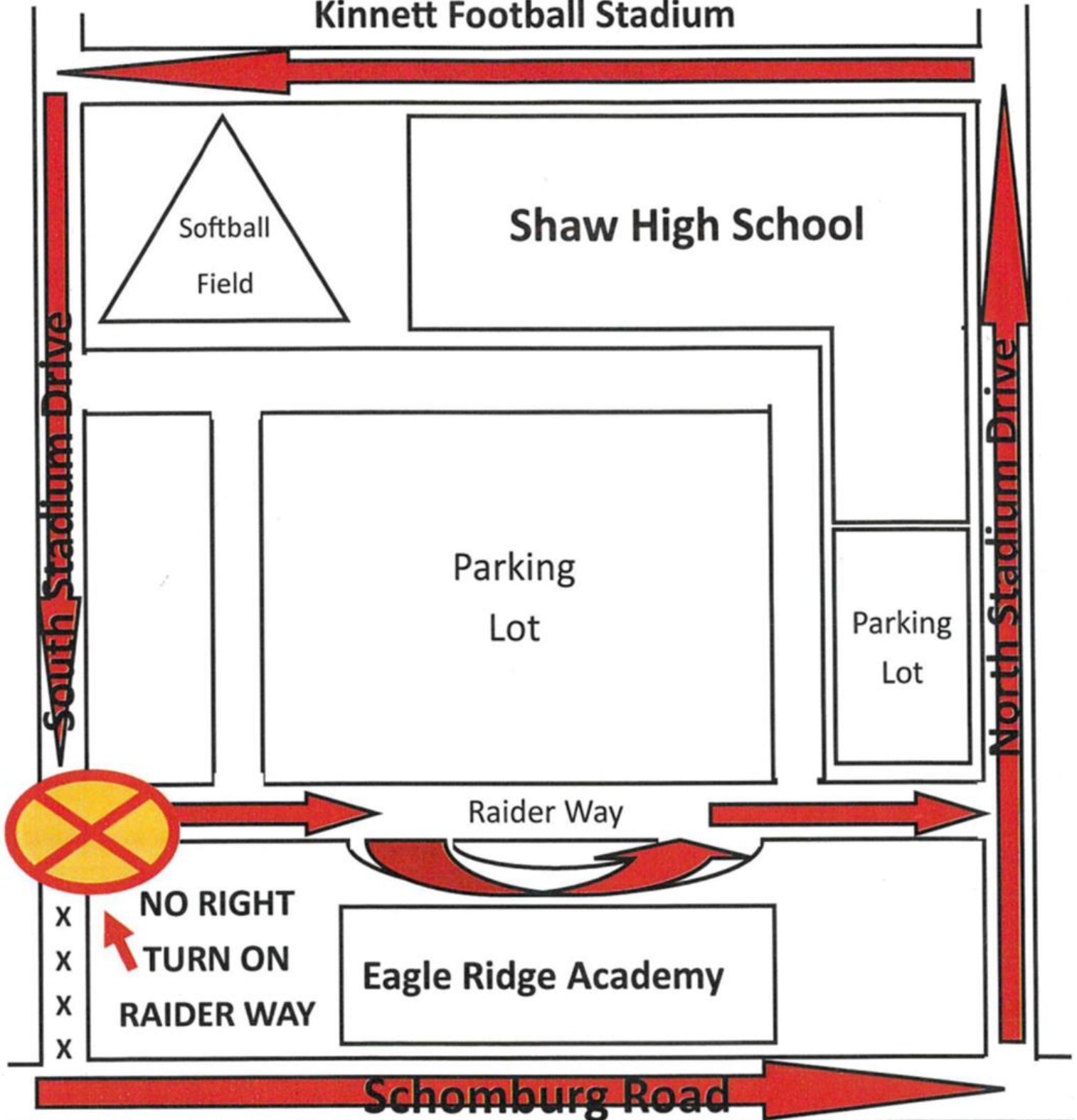
