what type of Lehavior?

Minor behaviors are handled by the classroom teacher and include behaviors such as:

- Excessive talking
- Argumentative/yelling
- Out of seat without permission
- Rough play
- · Taking other's property
- Offensive remarks in a casual manner
- · Cheating (Ist offense)
- · Improper technology use

Major behaviors are handled by admin on the first offense and include behaviors such as:

- Throwing objects
- Walking out
- Intentional fighting
- · Remarks to harass
- Bullying/Cyberbullying
- Taking other's property (repeated offense)
- Inappropriate paraphernalia
- Inappropriate touching
- Cheating (repeated)
- Inappropriate technology

Major behavior

Intervention

- Complete ODR
- Conference with student
- Communicate with parents

Administrative Response

- Admin investigates ODR
- Student conduct is consulted
- Admin determines necessary intervention
- Admin provides feedback to teacher

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
