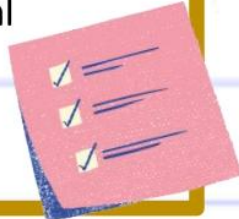
Character Word for April - Integrity

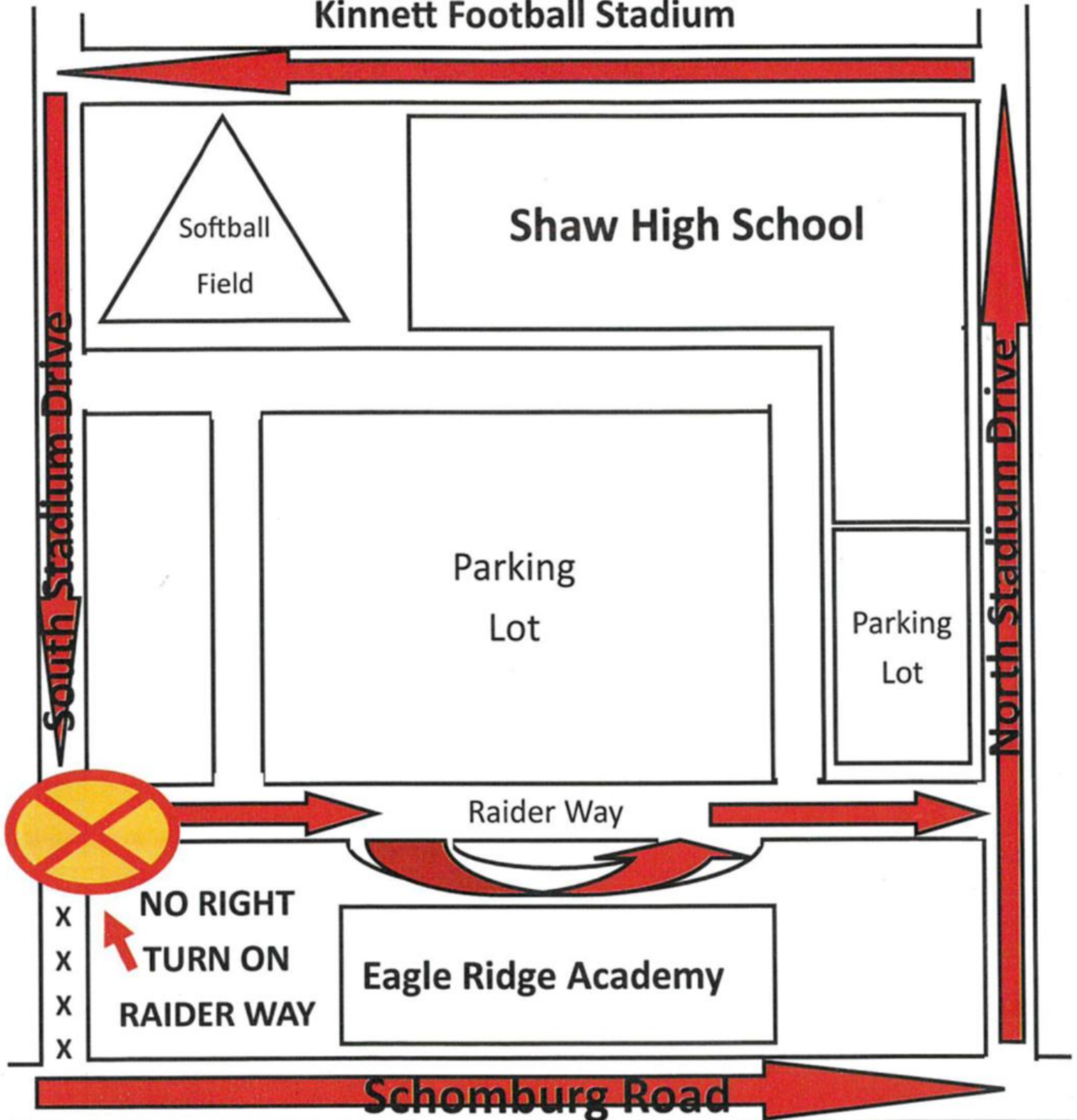
