MCSD TAPP candidates commit to 3 years at their assigned school. This includes time in the program.

If I'm a current MCSD employee, can I stay at my current school while enrolled in MCSD GaTAPP?

If the school is included in the list that MCSD GaTAPP serves <u>and</u> the Principal recommends the candidate for a full-time teaching position that aligns with the certification the candidate is seeking via GaTAPP, it is <u>possible</u> that a current employee may stay at the same school while enrolled in GaTAPP. However, there is no guarantee.
