PASS YOUR CLASS THE **FIRST** TIME.

In High School you are required to PASS all required classes for GRADUATION.

Refer to your Muscogee County Course Requirements Plan worksheet.

Graduation Requirements

- ▶ You must have **16 credits to be a Senior** and **23 to graduate**.
- ▶ **Required Courses:**
 - ▶ 9th Grade Lit, 10th Grade Lit, American Lit, Multicultural Lit
 - ▶ Algebra I, Geometry, Algebra II, 4th year Math (College Readiness Mathematics, Pre-Calculus, Statistics, or Math of Finance) **Math of Finance is not accepted at a 4-year university**, but is accepted at 2-year colleges or technical schools.
 - ▶ Environmental Science, Biology, Physical Science, 4th year Science (Zoology, Human Physiology, Chemistry, Forensic Science)
 - ▶ American Gov./Civ., World History, U.S. History, Economics
 - ▶ Personal Fitness/Health
 - ▶ 2 of the same foreign language (for 4-year universities and colleges only; not a high school graduation requirement)

Getting Ready for Pre-Registration

- ▶ Planning your classes for high school is important in order to ensure you stay on track for Graduation.
- ▶ Today you are getting a Course Planner to help you track the classes you have passed and the ones you will need next year.
- ▶ When you return to school in August of 2018, don't assume you have been placed in the correct classes. It is part of the student's responsibility to make sure the correct classes are on the schedule.
- ▶ If you see a mistake, you will let your school counselor know a change needs to be made.

Summer Credit Recovery

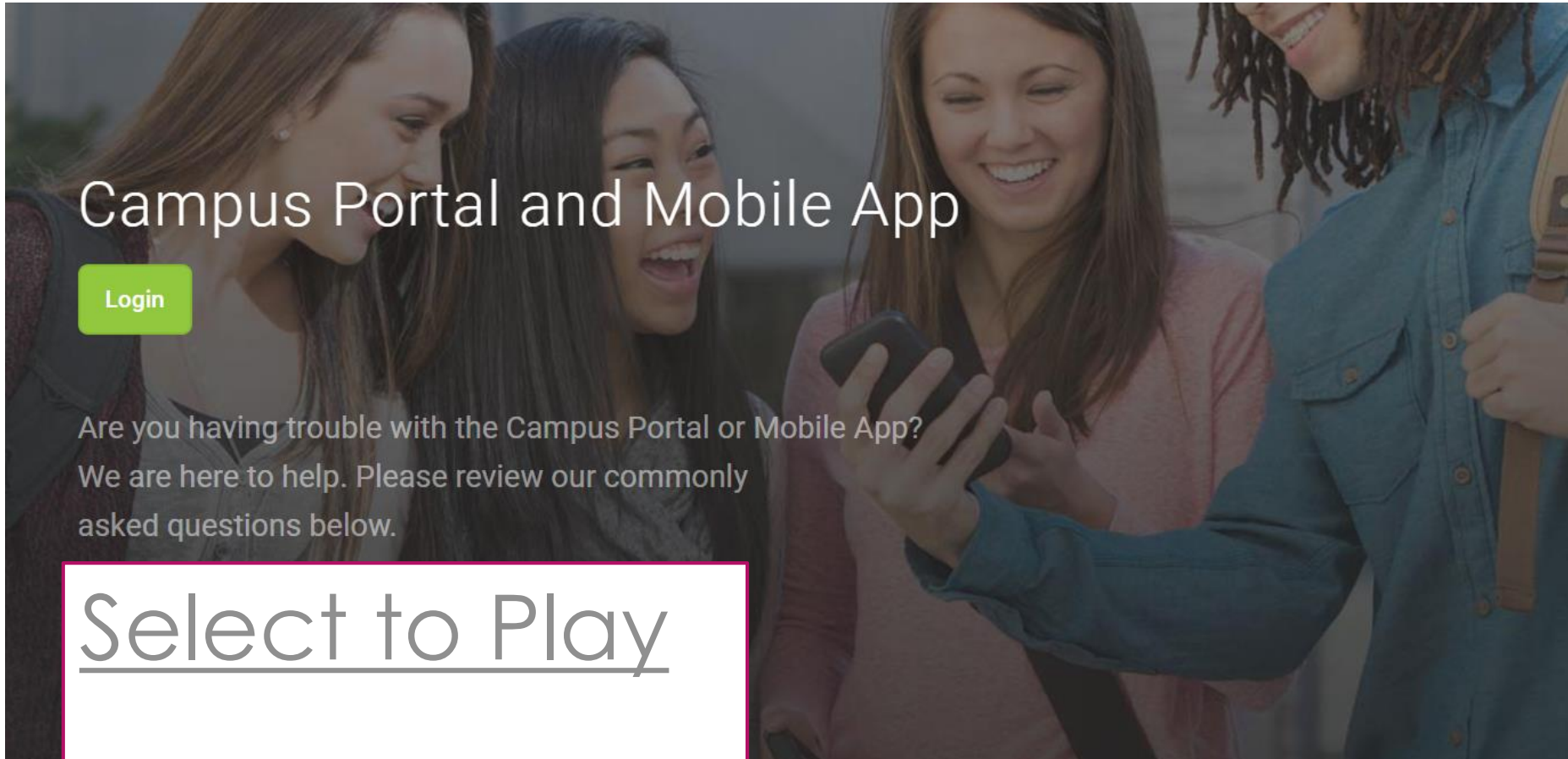
- ▶ If you failed a required course for graduation, you have options to retake the course in the summer either at:
 - ▶ Hardaway (free if you qualify to attend)
 - ▶ Education & Guidance Services (costs money)
 - ▶ Hallie Turner (costs money)
- ▶ At Hardaway if you register for a Summer Recovery Course and choose to not attend or do not finish the course, you will be responsible for paying **\$25.00** to re-enroll in the GA Credit Recovery course later.

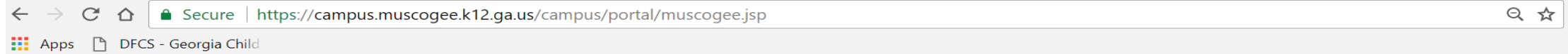
