

Diploma Programme

- 6 Diploma Courses (one from each "group")
- 3 SL, 3 HL
- TOK, CAS, EE

Career Programme

- 2-4 Diploma Courses
- Complete Career Path
- No SL/HL requirement
- PPS, CAS, RP, LDP

IF YOU FAIL A COURSE IN ANY SUBJECT, YOU ARE NO LONGER ELIGIBLE TO CONTINUE TAKING HHSPIB OR IB COURSES IN THAT SUBJECT.*

What does this mean for DP students? What does it mean for CP students?

*The only exception to this is if you do not pass HHSPIB Chemistry but already have credit for Physical Science and Environmental.

IB English Course Sequence

- 9th HHSPIB 9th Grade Lit.
- 10th HHSPIB American Lit.
- 11th IB English A: Literature Year 1 (HL)
- 12th IB English A: Literature Year 2 (HL)

IB Language B Course Sequence

- 9th HHSPIB Spanish, French, or Latin 1 OR Spanish 2*
- 10th HHSPIB Spanish, French, or Latin 2 OR Spanish 3*
- 11th HHSPIB Spanish, French, or Latin 3 OR IB Spanish Year 1 (SL)*
- 12th IB Spanish Year 1 (SL)**, IB French Year 1 (SL)**, or IB Latin Year 1 (SL) OR IB Spanish Year 2 (HL)
- *Only available if you received HS credit for Spanish 1 in MS
- **If you did not begin Spanish or French until 10th grade, you can still complete an "entry level" Spanish or French IB course sequence by 12th grade ab inicio (SL)

IBDP students MUST take an exam for a Language B course

IB Social Studies Course Sequence

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9<sup>th</sup> – HHSPIB Civics/HHSPIB Econ.*
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- 10th HHSPIB US History
- 11th HHSPIB World History
- 12th IB 20th Century World History (SL)** *OR*IB History of the Americas (HL)** *AND/OR*IB World Religions (SL)
- *If you began the IB social studies track in 9th grade and to not wish to complete it, please know that you will have to retake an entire year of Economics to meet graduation requirements.
- **The Historical Investigation from Mr. Schrage's class will carry over into 20th Century. or History of the Americas, but you will have to write a new paper if you take World Religions.

IB Science Course Sequence

- 9th HHSPIB Phys. Sci. OR HHSPIB Environmental*
- 10th HHSPIB Environmental OR HHSPIB Chemistry
- 11th IB Biology Year 1 (SL/HL)
- 12th IB Biology Year 2 (SL/HL) and/or IB Environmental Systems and Societies (SL)

*Only if you had Pre-AP Physical Science in 8th grade.

IB Mathematics Course Sequence

Non-accelerated

9th – HHSPIB Algebra I

10th – HHSPIB Geometry

11th – HHSPIB Algebra II

12th – IB Math Studies Year 1 (SL)

Accelerated

9th – HHSPIB Accel. Algebra/Geometry

10th – HHSPIB Accel. Geometry/Alg. II

11th – IB Mathematics Year 1 (SL/HL*)

12th – IB Mathematics Year 1 (SL/HL*)

^{*}Students interested in IB Mathematics HL must be recommended for the course by the IB Mathematics teacher at the end of 11th grade. IB Mathematics HL is not recommended for any student who is not prepared for independent study work.

IB Elective Course Sequence - Music

- 9th Performance class (band, chorus, orchestra, etc.)
- 10th HHSPIB Music Theory + Performance Class
- 11th IB Music Year 1 (SL/HL) + Performance Class*
- 12th IB Music Year 2 (SL/HL) + Performance Class*

*IB Music and performance class will alternate during the same class period.

IB Elective Course Sequence — Theatre & Visual Arts

Theatre

9th – HHSPIB Drama 1

10th – Theatre 2 OR HHSPIB Drama 1

11th – IB Theatre Year 1 (SL/HL)

12th – IB Theatre Year 2 (SL/HL)

Visual Arts

9th – HHSPIB Art 1

10th – Art 2 OR HHSPIB Art 1

11th – IB Visual Arts Year 1 (SL/HL)

12th – IB Visual Arts Year 2 (SL/HL)

Other Possible IB Electives

- 3-4 years of a second IB World Language (if you have already begun both languages)
- 2nd IB Experimental Science (during senior year only)*
- 2nd IB Social Studies (during senior year only)

*if available

Graduation Requirements

- 9th Grade Lit., American Lit, + 2 more literature courses
- Government(1/2 credit), US History, World History, Economics
- Physical Science; Biology; Chemistry, Earth Science,
 Environmental Science, or AP/IB science; + 1 more science
 credit
- Algebra I, Geometry, Algebra II, + 1 more math course
- Health & Personal Fitness
- 3 credits of CTAE, World Language, &/or Fine Arts (you must have two credits in the same world language to attend a 4 year university)
- 4 elective credits
- It is also suggested that you complete some pathway whether career, advanced academic, world language, or fine arts

Move on When Ready

- IB and MOWR/Dual Enrollment do NOT mix...
- You cannot complete the IB program requirements and Dual Enroll UNLESS it is designed as a part of completing your career pathway.
- While "free college" is very tempting, that is not the whole story
