

Muscogee County School District will phase in the reopening of in-person classes starting September 14, 2020 for ninth grade students and students who are in self-contained specialized classes. Those students will be allowed to return to in-person instruction on September 14, 2020 if they chose the in-person instructional model. Sophomores, Juniors and Seniors will remain in virtual classes.

Beginning on September 21, 2020 all students may attend in-person classes, which is inclusive of Sophomores, Juniors, and Seniors if the parent selected the in-person model. Students who chose virtual must remain for the entire nine weeks and can only change at the beginning of each nine week grading period. Parents and guardians have until September 4, 2020 to make or change the choice for their children. Please do not hesitate to contact the school if you have any questions or concerns. - **Specialized/Self-Contained classes include:** Autism Self-Contained; Deaf/Hard of Hearing; GNETS; Severe/Profound, Moderate Intellectual Disabilities; Visual Impairment; Orthopedic Impairment; Significant Developmentally Delayed; Pre-K Special Education Self-Contained, Ready 2 Work, Ready 4 Life, Project Search, Providing Adults Transition Service, Behavior Supports Collaborative, Behavior Supports Therapeutic and Behavior Supports Functional self-contained; English to Speakers of Other Languages (ESOL)
- **Parents can change their student declaration for virtual or in-person instruction via their student's assigned school by 12:00 noon, September 4, 2020.**
