**Samantha Cruz** has been admitted to Columbus State University where she plans to pursue a nursing degree. She has been a hospital volunteer and volunteer tutor.



**Jocelyn Fowler** will be a student at Columbus State University. She plans to major in biology and is interested in architecture and art, also.



**Keisha McCray** has been accepted at Savanna State University. She plans to major in business administration and minor in marketing.



**Brisseida Melchor-Tinoco** will attend Columbus State University to study biology. Her long-term plan is a career in nursing or orthodontia.

The **Kendrick High School Alumni Scholarship** was established in 2020 to honor the 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary of Kendrick’s first graduating class, the Class of 1970. In spite of the COVID pandemic, Class of 1970 members raised money and were able to grant a total of \$7,000 in scholarships to three members of the Class of 2020.

Even though COVID continued to present a fund-raising challenge and thanks to one especially generous donor, the second year of the Alumni Scholarship program produced donations totaling just over \$10,000; six scholarships were granted to Class of 2021 graduates. Five Class of 2022 graduates were awarded a total of \$7,500.

The Kendrick Alumni Scholarship can be used at accredited colleges, universities and technical schools to pay for tuition, lab fees, textbooks, technology fees and activity fees. Grants are not limited to use at Georgia post-secondary institutions.
