Senior Dinner Wednesday, May 7th

- Attire: Business
- Parents who have paid the reservation fee should arrive at 6:00 p.m.
- Parents will be checked in at the front door before being seated.
- The dinner will begin at 6:00 p.m. at the Cunningham Center





- The picnic will be held at Cascade Hills Park. Seniors will come to school and report to their classes and be called when it's time to load the busses.
- The picnic will be held from 10am-1pm.
- Seniors are REQUIRED to wear their Senior T-Shirt to the picnic.
- Seniors may wear basketball shorts to the picnic.
- Parent tickets are not offered for attendance to this event.

Baccalaureate Practice

- Friday, May 16th

- Seniors will report to school for the day and conduct business as usual.
 - -Students will attend the senior picnic
 - Baccalaureate practice will be held once seniors return to the school after the picnic.





BACCALAUREATE Sunday, May 18th

- Baccalaureate is MANDTORY for all graduating seniors. ONLY STUDENTS WHO ARE GRADUATING ARE ALLOWED TO PARTICIPATE IN BACCALAUREATE.
- Seniors will report to the school's Main Office
 Lobby for Baccalaureate by 2:15 p.m. The service will start promptly at 3:00 p.m. Tickets will not be issued; it will be first come, first served.
- Seniors will need to wear their gown and hood only

 do not wear the cap. Clothes under the gown are
 the same as for graduation. (more on that later)





 Students will be provided with 20 tickets
 Graduation Tickets will be distributed when students clear for graduation with Mrs.
 Johnson-Fleming.



KHS Grad Practice

Tuesday, May 20th

After completing state clearance, Seniors must attend a <u>mandatory</u> graduation practice in the Kendrick High School gym. Students will report to the Gym promptly at 9:00 a.m. <u>Do Not Be Late!</u> Enter the building through the <u>Back doors by the bus loop ONLY</u> - <u>DO NOT GO INTO THE BUILDING.</u>

- Upon conclusion of practice, seniors will then be released to go home and are NOT allowed in the building.
- Students must be in school dress code.



MCSD Grad Practice – Wednesday, May 21st

Seniors MUST report to the Columbus Civic Center for a MANDATORY GRADUATION PRACTICE. Seniors should arrive by 10:45 a.m. Practice will end approximately at 12:30 p.m.. Seniors will be released from the Columbus Civic Center to return home. Seniors **CANNOT** bring any food or drink into the Civic Center. Students will not be allowed to participate in the graduation ceremony if they miss graduation practice at the Civic Center. Seniors are dismissed to go home after practice. All graduates will need to bring and wear their 7 graduation shoes for the whole rehearsal.

GRADUATION Thursday, May 22nd Seniors will participate in their **GRADUATION** ceremony at the Columbus Civic Center at 8:00 p.m. **SENIORS MUST ARRIVE AT THE CIVIC CENTER FOR LINE-UP at 7:00 p.m.**

Any senior who is not in line for graduation at the designated time (7 p.m.) and wearing the appropriate clothes and shoes will not be allowed to participate in the ceremony.

This has to be said (3) **Any senior who incurs disciplinary** action during any graduation activity will be assigned 20 hours of community service and will not receive their diploma until the community service has been completed. This includes the graduation ceremony.

What to Wear

Graduation Attire: Dress Code must comply with school dress code. Males - Black dress slacks, white dress shirt with a collar, black tie (bow tie OK), black dress shoes, and black socks (no jeans or tennis shoes allowed). **Females – WHITE dress (shorter then the** gown), black shoes (heels 3 in or less or flats – no stilettos)- black dress sandals must have a heel strap.

Baccalaureate – Same dress code-but <u>no</u> <u>cap.</u>

What to Wear, cont.

• Do not wear bracelets or necklaces.



 Seniors will not be allowed to participate in graduation if they do not adhere to the dress code. Please contact one of the administrators or one of your child's teachers if you need help in attaining the proper attire. SENIORS CANNOT CHEW GUM during the ceremony! Seniors are not allowed to **BRING PURSES, KEYS, CELL PHONES, OR ANYTHING ELSE TO HOLD**. The Civic Center security guards will not allow them into the building if they are carrying anything.

What to Wear, cont.

- All graduates will need to bring and wear their graduation shoes for the whole rehearsal.
- Seniors are not allowed to alter their Caps in any manner for graduation day.
 All seniors need to be uniformed for the

ceremony.



How to wear graduation attire:



Girls - Lets talk about shoes for a second. 3" heels! NO TALLER! So how tall is 3"?



To give you an idea – 3" is the size of a clothespin.

But you can wear a bow tie if you'd like.

No; you don't want to look like this:





- Seniors not graduating or not participating in the above events will attend regularly scheduled classes. Attendance does count.
- Missing graduation practice at the Civic Center will result in a student not participating in the graduation ceremony.
- Students speaking or performing at Baccalaureate and/or Graduation may be required to remain later on certain days for additional practice.





What MCSD wants you to

know....aka Graduation Protocol

Graduation Protocol: In order for everyone to enjoy this occasion, we ask all guests to observe the following:

- A. Please help your student to be on time for graduation. They must be at the Civic Center by 7:00 p.m. on May 22nd for line-up. The ceremony will begin promptly at 8:00 p.m. and will last approximately 1½ hours.
- **B.** Graduates should leave their cell phones and other personal belongings in their car or with a family member prior to line-up.
- **C.** No items of recognition may be worn unless provided by Kendrick faculty for the purpose of graduation (i.e. honor cords, stoles, Top 10 medals)
- **D. Graduates should not do anything during the ceremony to call attention to themselves.**



What MCSD wants you to

know...aka Graduation Protocol

- E. MCSD does not permit posters, banners, balloons, noisemakers, cowbells etc. in the Civic Center during graduation.
- F. Do not rope off or save seats in the Civic Center
- **G.** Have a designated location outside to meet your graduate after the ceremony.
- H. Every student and parent deserves to hear each student's name called. The audience is only allowed to applaud after the entire row receives their diplomas. This is nothing more than common courtesy and respect for others. Applauding or calling out the names for individuals will result in automatic expulsion from the Civic Center and disciplinary action against your graduating senior.

What MCSD wants you to Know...aka Graduation Protocol

-Cameras and video equipment are welcome; however, parents are not allowed on the Civic Center floor at any time before, during, or after the ceremony. Professional graduation pictures may also be ordered.

-Please remain seated until the recessional march has completed before you exit the auditorium.

-Specialty seating is limited – please get there early.


