Presents The 2026 Kendrick High School Scholarship

Eligibility- This \$2,500 scholarship opportunity is available to graduating seniors at Kendrick High School who meet the following requirements. Must be a 2026 graduating senior at Kendrick High School, and be between 17 and 19 years old. Must be a U.S citizen.

Scholarship Purpose- The Marshman Scholarship Foundation (MFS) established this award to support talented and deserving students in their pursuit of higher education. Our goal is to provide financial assistance to those who demonstrate both academic excellence and a commitment to their community.

Scholarship Requirements

- 1. Applicants must have an unweighted cumulative GPA between "2.50 and 3.59" upon graduation.
- 2. A copy of your HS transcripts must be submitted with your applicant packet. Your guidance counselor must sign the transcript copy.
- 3. Applicants must have completed a minimum of **50 hours of community service**. Please provide documentation of your service hours, such as service logs or certificates. Note that volunteer hours cannot be completed at a relative's business or organization. Documentation must include the following information: your name, the hours completed, a contact number, and the name of the organization.
- 4. Applicants should demonstrate leadership roles in school or community projects. This can include positions such as club president, team captain, or project leader. Evidence must include letters of recommendation or detailed descriptions of leadership roles.
- 5. Applicants need to submit **two letters of recommendation**. These should be from teachers, mentors, or community leaders who can speak to the applicant's character, academic abilities, and potential. Letters should be recent and specific to the applicant's qualifications, with a signature block.
- 6. Applicants must write a [1250]-word essay addressing the given topic." Who Are You?" Please share what makes you uniquely exceptional and how your individuality contributes to the world around you. Describe how you represent your community and the ways in which you strive to embody the qualities of a well-rounded individual. How will this scholarship impact your journey? Explain how receiving this scholarship will serve as a pivotal step in your journey toward fulfilling your purpose. Share your vision for how this opportunity will enable you to grow, achieve your goals, and ultimately come full circle by giving back to your community in meaningful ways. The essay should reflect the applicant's ability to articulate thoughts, demonstrate critical thinking, and provide personal insight. The essay must be in MLA format and a Title Page must be included.
- 7. Applicants must be accepted to a **4-year college**. A copy of your official college acceptance letter must accompany your packet.

Every student packet will include your basic information. This includes your name, address, phone number, email, date of birth, high school or college details, and other identifying material.

All packets must be submitted between May 11 - May 15, 2026. All packets must be sent digitally to Marshmanscholarship@gmail.com no later than 11:59 pm EST on 15 May 2026.

The winner will be awarded the 2026 MSF Scholarship at the Annual Heroes Ball held on 25 July 2026. All applicants must attend the ball. Each participant will receive an invitation to the Heroes Ball once their scholarship packet is submitted. Applicant ticket will be paid for by MSF, but parents, family, or guardians must purchase a ticket to attend.
