Masks: MCSD has not have lifted the mask mandate yet... Please provide a mask for your child every day until MCSD lifts the mask mandate.

Attendance: When your student is absent please send a note with your hand-written signature to your teacher upon your student(s) within three days of your student(s) returning. Your teacher will then send that note to the attendance clerk. We cannot accept emails, dojo or text messages for attendance notes.

Cafeteria: Please do not send sodas or carbonated drinks to school in your children's lunch boxes. They spew all over when they open them and make a sticky mess. They may have milk, water, or juice.

Classroom: We try our best to not disrupt teacher's classrooms throughout the day. Please help us do so, by ensuring your child leaves the house with all necessary items (i.e. lunch boxes, water bottles, back packs, mask, transportation notes, club forms, etc.).

Clinic: We are requesting that you keep your child at home if they are not feeling well in any way. The following is MCSD policy on how long they must be home if they have the following symptoms.

Fever – 48 hours fever free with no fever reducing medicine during that time

Strep – 48 hours after the first dose of medicine and no fever, vomiting or diarrhea.

Vomiting or Diarrhea – 48 hours after it has stopped.

COVID: If you have had your child tested for COVID, please keep your child home until you receive the test results. Upon a positive test result, please contact the school for instructions.

Parent portal: If you need access to parent portal please stop by the school 8:30AM – 1:30 PM with your id so that we can give you your information or reset your password. MCSD only uses parent portal. **The one that you can see in Canvas is not used by MCSD.**

Tardies: Students need to be in the building by 7:40 so that they can be in their seats by 7:45. The car line opens at 7:15 AM. We will close the car line off at 7:45 so that the staff

Transportation: If you need to change your child's transportation it must be done in writing with your signature and come in with your student in the morning. If you need to make a transportation change during the day you must bring the note to the front office.

Visiting: At this time we are not able to let parents and family visit classrooms or eat lunch with their students.

Withdrawals: Please note that we require 48 school hours to process a withdrawal. Please stop by the office and fill out the form as soon as you know that you will be moving.
