## Schedule:

## Reading and ELA Activities:

-Read the decodable book or story from this week (or any previous week) independently and make a list of any words that you do not know.

-Practice your spelling words using any of the homework activities or write each spelling word 3 times.

-Write each dictation sentence 3 times and trace the capital letter and punctuation on each sentence with a crayon.

-Write your sight words onto index cards 2 times and play a memory matching game with the cards, or read your sight words to a stuffed animal, or write your sight words 5 times each and add the heart parts

-Work in Lexia if you have internet connection

-Read books in the Tumblebooks app in Clever if you know how

- Turn over 2 cards from a deck of playing cards or Uno cards. All face cards are worth 10. Write the 2 numbers in an addition sentence. Solve the addition problem.
- Write the numbers 1-10 on index cards. Pick 2 numbers from the cards. Write an addition sentence using the 2 numbers and solve it.
- Work in IXL on your computer if you have internet connection
- Work in iReady on your computer if you have internet connection

### **Social Studies Activities:**

- Write down facts or draw pictures from your study guide
- Work on your location project where you label and illustrate your continent (North America), country (United States of America), state (Georgia), county (Muscogee), city (Columbus) and home address.
- Listen to patriotic music
- Draw a picture of our flag, the white house, the Statue of Liberty, or the bald eagle
- Draw a picture of how you celebrate the 4<sup>th</sup> of July
- Find North America, the United States of America, Georgia, Muscogee County, and Columbus on a map
