Answers on their applications should provide a clear indication of this quality. Selecting these types of students will ensure your year is productive and successful.
Passionate Presence	Student passion can show up in many ways--open and expressive or quiet and focused. Simply stated: students with passion, care--they are not apathetic. Many students have displaced passion, but if aimed in a positive direction, they can become a force to make a difference in the world. Choose passionate students and watch them impact your school!

"How do I introduce my students to Chick-fil-A Leader Academy?"

Chick-fil-A Leader Academy is open to 30 students grades 9-12. We recommend introducing Chick-fil-A Leader Academy to your school using the announcement video and/or script located in the resources tab on your Activation Station.
