Washington Youth Tour Contest Rules

Any student who has previously participated in the Washington Youth Tour is not eligible to enter the contest.

The student must be at least 16 years of age at the time of the tour. Only those students whose parents or legal guardians receive electric service from Diverse Power are eligible to enter the contest.

Each contest participant must submit a 500 word autobiography. The autobiography should include information on the applicant's involvement in the community, awards, achievements, affiliations, etc.

A contest entry form must be submitted by each participant.

Personal interviews will be conducted with all applicants to assist the panel in selecting contest winners.

The contest winners will be selected by a panel of judges based on the essays, the information provided on the contest entry forms and the personal interviews.
