SUBJECT: Rules for Fort Moore-Columbus Post, 2024 SAME Scholarship

1. Four scholarships will be awarded.
 - A. \$2,000 one-year scholarship
 - B. \$1,500 one-year scholarship
 - C. \$1,500 one-year scholarship
 - D. \$1,500 one-year scholarship
2. The scholarship will be awarded to a high school senior, or college freshman student enrolled in or accepted into an approved two or four-year curriculum leading to a degree in Engineering, Engineering Technology or related program. Student's permanent home residence must be within a 50-mile radius of Fort Moore, Georgia.
3. Award of this scholarship will be based on past and present academic attainment, student activities, recommendation and interest in engineering and/or the military. In addition, enrollment in a ROTC program is a good indicator of interest in Military Engineering, but ROTC enrollment is not a requirement for scholarship eligibility.
4. Award of the scholarship will be recommended by a selection panel in accordance with the by-laws of the Fort Moore-Columbus Post of The Society of American Military Engineers.
5. Payment will be made to the student after proof is furnished of enrollment in a school that is consistent with the student's application. Applications must be mailed to the Fort Moore-Columbus Post, SAME, by the student.
6. Applications shall be submitted using the application form attached and postmarked no later than Friday, March 1, 2024.
7. The scholarship winners will be announced at our Annual SAME Golf Tournament at Maple Ridge Golf Club. All winners will be given a free one-year membership to the Society of American Military Engineers.
