Army Youth Program in Your Neighborhood (AYPYN)



The Department of the Army, IMCOM G9 Family and Morale, Welfare and Recreation (MWR) Child Youth Services (CYS) is committed to expanding the availability of high quality, high interest after school programs for Army-connected youth who attend secondary schools off the installation, where a high concentration of Army families reside. To help meet the need, AYPYN programs were developed to provide sponsored off-post Youth Programs as a supplement to Army operated on-post programs.

Army-connected youth is any youth whose parent/guardian is one of the following:

- Army Active Duty
- Army Reserve, Activated
- National Guard, Activated
- Department of Army Civilian
- Gold Star Spouse

The Army provides financial support to AYPYN sites to assist with the expenses and improvement of quality afterschool activities. The amount of funding support depends on how many Army-connected Youth spaces are being served at each AYPYN site*.
