## Tryout Dates and Attire

- Tryouts will be held April 21-22 in the Northside High School Gym
- All candidates must wear the following each day of the tryouts:
  - o A <u>plain white</u> t-shirt or sports tank with sports bra
  - o Black shorts of appropriate length
  - o Tennis shoes or Cheer Shoes
- Candidates may demonstrate their stunting, tumbling, and jumping abilities.

## Statement of Permission and Understanding

If you make the cheerleading squad, realize that you are making a commitment to Northside High School, your coaches, your teammates, and yourself for the **entire** cheerleading season. The decision to tryout should not be taken lightly. You will be expected to put cheerleading as one of your top priorities. Furthermore, as a representative of Northside, you must maintain proper behavior at all times. This includes inside and outside of the classroom. Grades, behavior and attendance are expected to be satisfactory during the season and will be checked prior to tryouts. You must follow the cheerleading guidelines. Students who break the rules will be disciplined. By making this commitment to the Northside High School Cheerleading Program, you will receive many valuable and rewarding experiences that you will remember long after you graduate from high school. These activities will not only channel your enthusiasm and spirit in a constructive and beneficial manner, but will give you a sense of pride and accomplishment in being a part of such an amazing team.

#### Practice Obligations:

- Mat practices Monday-Thursday mornings 7:00-8:30 am
- Sideline and Game day practice will be Tuesday and Thursday afternoons 4-5:30pm

#### Financial Obligations:

- Total financial obligation for new cheerleaders is \$1,750 (returning is \$1,5500). Fundraisers will be offered, but uniform fees are due in April prior to fundraisers.
- Booster Club Fees are \$500. These fees go towards all practice apparel, bows, poms, transportation, away game meals, GHSA memberships, team bonding, competition fees, game day competition fees, cleaning mats, end of the year gifts for the cheerleaders, end of the year banquet, senior gifts, etc.
- Camp and Choreography fees are \$300. These fees go towards June 12 stunt clinic, June 17-18 Competition Choreography camp, July 14-15 game day choreography camp and lunches, music.
- Coaching and Competition fees are \$250. These fees go towards coaching stipends (\$1000HC/\$1500AC/\$1500 AC) and competition entry fees (3 + state) and 2 game day competitions (region & state).
- Each cheerleader must have her/his account paid for in full by September 4. Please refer to the tentative payment schedule below.

Money paid to the Booster Club is non-refundable if your child quits or is removed from the team for any reason all money paid is forfeited.
