

# Community Service Hours

## Getting Started

### Step 1

- Choose **ONE approved agency** that interests you
- Approved list is on the NHS website under the **Magnet Tab**

### Step 2

- Contact the agency – this is your responsibility
- Things to consider: is the location too far, will I be able to earn enough hours, do I meet the age requirements?
- Sign up to volunteer following their instructions

### Step 3

- Complete the **Community Service Registration Form**
- Form is on the NHS website under **Magnet Tab**

### Step 4

- **Track your hours using:**
  - NHS Log Sheet
    - Paper Copies**
      - Outside Mrs. Fuller's office or from advisement teacher
      - Digital Copies**
        - NHS website under **Magnet Tab** OR
    - Agency log sheet

## **Important Guidelines**

### **Students MUST**

- Complete ALL 25 hours with **ONE authorized agency**
- Register every school year on the community service registration form

### **Students MAY**

- Stay with the same approved agency next year
- Choose a different approved agency next year

### **Students MAY NOT**

- Have a relative supervising volunteer hours
- Miss school to complete hours
- Earn hours during the school day: field days, Blood drive, etc.

### **Hours Should Be Completed**

- Before or after school
- Weekends
- Summer, holidays and school breaks

### **Deadline**

- **25 service hours required**
- **NEW – minimum of 10 hours must be submitted by Friday, December 18, 2026**
- Remaining hours are due no later than Friday, **May 7, 2027**

### **Important Reminders**

- Rising juniors should already have submitted 50+ hours
  - Extra hours may roll over in the following year
