Dear Parents,

We are soliciting school-specific project ideas from all of our stakeholders for a future ESPLOST. It is very important that parents be provided opportunities to provide input in these projects. We wanted to ensure that every parent had an opportunity to make known any ideas in which they think these funds could benefit Richards Middle School. Here are a few important points to remember:

- ESPLOST funds can only be used for capital improvements, new schools, buses, renovations and technology.
- ESPLOST funds <u>may not</u> be utilized for personnel, instructional supplies, etc.
- A definitive date has not yet been set by the Board of Education for an ESPLOST to appear on a ballot but will be soon
- The primary message is that our ESPLOST would be a continuation of the one-cent sales tax that has been in place for twenty years
- The Citizens' ESPLOST Committee has validated that all projects specified in the current and previous ESPLOSTS have been completed or are underway
