Muscogee County School District is excited to announce Richards Middle School's participation in the *Personalized Learning Initiative*. While personalized learning encompasses many aspects, the main focus is an environment where learning is tailored to a student's individual educational needs and allows students to utilize technology in achieving learning goals.

Here are a few things to know:

What / When? Distribution of Chromebooks will take place on September 10, 2019 where every student will be assigned a Chromebook.

Why? This is an important step in moving to a *Personalized Learning* environment. The student-learning device gives students a valuable resource to use as a tool in classroom instruction.

How? Each student will be assigned a Chromebook to be utilized during the school day. Like all computers in our district, these devices will be monitored, protected and filtered for appropriate usage and content. Assigned devices will be housed in 6th period. In Middle School, students will pick up their devices each morning and are responsible for keeping up with their devices during the day. Students will assigned a device by serial number just as they receive a textbook number/barcode. Devices will then be returned to the charging cart at the end of the day in their 6th period class and secured.

The teachers of Richards Middle School are very excited about personalized learning and will expect students to follow classroom rules/procedures for usage times during work sessions. Please let us know if you have any questions or concerns. We are confident that this will be a huge step forward for our school, district, and a key to increasing student success in learning.

Please be sure to sign and return the Student and Parent Chromebook Use Agreement Form and Student and Parent G Suite for Education Account Agreement in order for your child to receive a Chromebook. **ALL Students are expected to return the signed forms!**


