#### **SMART Goal #1**

By May 2021, 100% of teachers in grades K-5 will demonstrate an increase in their knowledge and implementation of high impact teaching strategies to improve student proficiency in grade level skills related to project based learning across all content areas.

#### **Action Strategies**

- Teachers will continue to utilize <u>The Writing</u> <u>Strategies Book</u>, by Jennifer Serravallo, as an instructional guide for teaching effective writing strategies to students.
- Writing samples will be collected throughout the year, using a predetermined prompt and common grade level writing rubric.
- In house professional development will consist of teachers sharing writing goals, writing strategies, and record keeping of student progress.
- Personalized Learning (PL) professional development, specific to targeted instruction, led by the PL Team.

#### **SMART Goal #2**

By May 2021, our Tier II team will develop and train 100% of teachers in grades PK-5 on a written process for Tier II structures and interventions that builds capacity to support all students. 85% of teachers will implement the process with fidelity as measured by the Tier II section of the TFI and/or the Tier 2/Tier 3 Intervention Tracking tool.

#### **Action Strategies**

- The BESS screener will be used as an early identifier for students along with ODRS and attendance.
- Partner with GaDOE PBIS Team to provide trainings and coaching to teachers on evidencebased, multi-tiered supports and interventions.
- Tier 2 team will meet bi-monthly to examine data compiled on the Tier 2/Tier 3 tracking form, and problem solve around the area(s) of concern.
- MTSS Chair will meet bi-monthly with grade level teams to review the progress of interventions and determine the next steps based on student responses to interventions.
