Esperanza Fund Scholarship*

Deadline: April 1, 2023

Amount: Up to \$20,000

GPA Requirement: N/A

Description: The Esperanza Education Fund provides scholarships to students from Maryland, Virginia, and Washington, DC who are immigrants or the children of two immigrants. Applicants must be graduating seniors at a high school in the region; plan to enroll full-time in an accredited, public two year community college or four-year college/university in the US for the 2023-24 academic year; and have had a 2022 household income of less than \$100,000.

Generation Hope Scholarship*

Deadline: April 1, 2023

Abramson Scholarship Foundation

GPA Requirement: 2.75

Description: The Abramson Scholarship Program is more than financial support. All our Scholars receive mentoring support as well.
