Scholarship Resources

Below are some websites to find scholarship resources for high school students. For many of these websites, you will need to create an account in order to access scholarships. Note that all of these sites are FREE. If you are asked for money to visit the site, leave the webpage! You can get the same resources for free.

www.scholarships.com

Once you are at the main page, click “start your search.” You will then have to register in order to access scholarships. Registering includes putting in your basic information. Note: your parent can sign up as well. Once you put in your information, scholarships.com will begin emailing you scholarships based on your profile.

www.fastweb.com

This sign-up is just like www.scholarships.com. Once you are at the main page, click “start your search.” You will then have to register in order to access scholarships. Registering includes putting in your basic information. Note: your parent can sign up for FastWeb as well. Once you put in your information, FastWeb will begin emailing you scholarships based on your profile.

www.unigo.com

You do not need an account in order to access scholarships on Unigo; however, you need an account to get detailed information. Once you get to the main site, click on “Scholarships” under “3.6M” in the middle of the page. You should then reach a Scholarship Directory where you can browse scholarships by topic. For example, if you click on “Athletic Scholarships,” you will then be directed to a page with all types of athletic scholarships listed by sport. If you do not have an account, you cannot see all the details. You can either set up an account or simply Google the scholarship title to get more information.

www.cappex.com

Similar to the first two scholarship websites, you will need an account in order to access scholarships on Cappex. When you get to the site, click “start now” in order to input your information. Cappex will email you scholarships based on your profile.

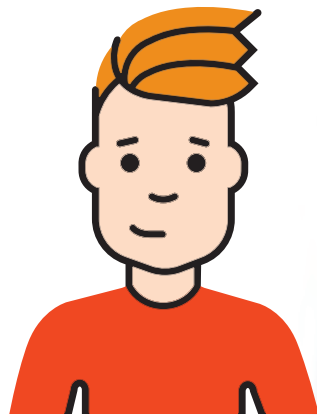

www.collegeboard.org

To access the scholarships, go to the main site and click on “College Planning” at the top. Then, go to where it says “Pay for College” at the top. Hover your cursor over “Pay for College” and click “Grants and Scholarships.” Then click on “Scholarship Search” and “Start” at the next page. You will then see a list of questions for you to fill out for your profile. You can click “See Results” to see all the scholarships based on your profile. You can also click “Save,” which allows you to save your scholarships, if you have a College Board account.

www.uncf.org

This website provides a number of scholarship opportunities for high school seniors, as well as college students. Once you are on the site, hover your cursor over “For Students” and click on “Scholarships.” You should then see a list of scholarships. If you want to apply to these, you can click “Apply,” and then will need to create a login to save your applications.
