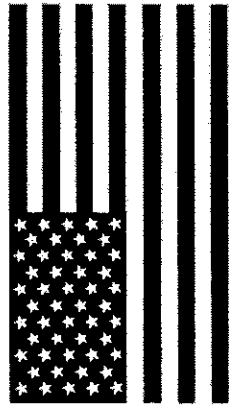


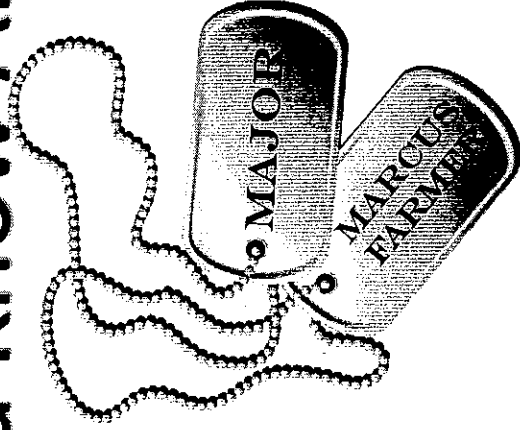

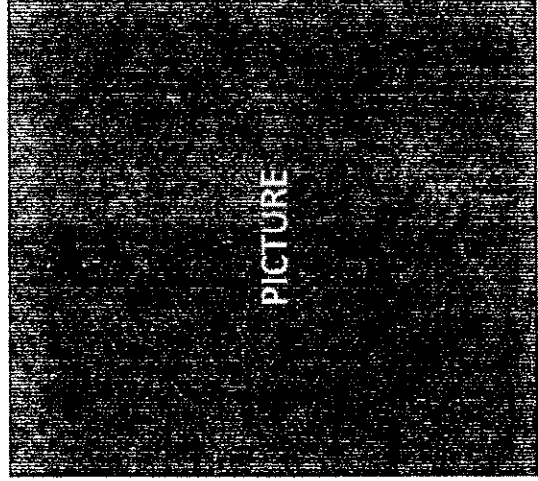

What You Should Know About My Veteran Veteran's Day Activity

In recognition and honor of Veteran's Day and The Month of the Military Family, Military Connected Students from across the Muscogee County School District are invited to create a poster and short video snippet recognizing their Veteran.

Students who would like to participate will create a small poster that represents their Veteran. The activity is open to children of any Veteran to include Active Duty Personnel, Retirees, National Guard, and Reservists from any of the Branches of Service.

The poster must:

- Be Landscape Orientation
- Be between the sizes of 11x14 inches and 16x20 inches for readability on camera
- Be Creative (It may include a photo of the Veteran and their Branch of Service)

After the student's poster is created, have someone record a short video snippet where the student says the Veteran's name while holding the poster. For example: SFC John Smith-My Dad. The video snippet is to be no more than 5 seconds in length.

The video snippet is to be sent to Dr. Rushaunda A. Farmer, Military Student Transition Consultant at farmer.rushaunda@muscogee.k12.ga.us **no later than November 16, 2020. All submissions must be accompanied by a release authorizing the use of the student's video and poster on the District's website and/or District's social media page(s).** A signed Acceptable Use Policy (AUP) for the 2020-2021 school year that has already been returned to the school may be used in lieu of a separate release.
